
Hi, I'm Esther.

All that's left of my palace today are ruins. They were fit for a queen. A queen like me!




My husband was a man named Ahasuerus. He ruled over the whole Persian empire.

I was Jewish. My people had been defeated by the Persians and we were forced to live in their country.




Ahasuerus did not know that I was Jewish, and he had an advisor named Haman, who did not like my people.




Haman convinced Ahasuerus to throw my people out of the empire, or to have us killed.


With God's help, I found the strength to go before Ahasuerus, and to tell him the truth.
